ZERO POINTS: Student failed to turn in a written script.	5 POINTS: Student improvised activity with little adherence to a written script	10 POINTS: Student provided a script that lacked detail necessary for activity performed (less than 15 steps).	15 POINTS: Student provided script but did not perform as written or was lacking a few details of activity.	20 POINTS: Student provided a complete written script for performance with detail by detail accuracy.
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PERFORMANCE: 60 POINTS

ZERO POINTS: Student refused to perform activity and was made aware of consequences.	15 POINTS: Pantomime was unclear overall, lacking attention to the pantomime concepts of weight, size and shape.	30 POINTS: Pantomime was clear, with frequent oversight of the pantomime concepts of weight, size or shape.	45 POINTS: Pantomime was clear, with few errors in relation to pantomime concepts of either weight, size, or shape.	60 POINTS: Pantomime was clear, with consistent proper application of the pantomime concepts of weight, size and shape.
